We encourage you to follow and consider these guidelines:

- Per the latest <u>CDC and CT guidelines</u>: Those who have been fully vaccinated (that is, two weeks after receiving the second Pfizer or Moderna shot, or two weeks after receiving the J & J shot) can resume activities without wearing a mask or staying 6 feet apart, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance. For those who have not been fully vaccinated, the CDC and state of CT are recommending that you continue to wear a mask and follow the social distancing rules. Masks will not be required indoors for those fully vaccinated.
- The two outer rows of seats by the windows will remain for those who would like to practice social distancing and/or wear a mask. The middle row of seats will not be socially distant and reserved for those who meet the guidelines for no longer wearing a mask. Hand sanitizer stations will be available upon entering/exiting and in the café.
- Our Children's Church is open for children age 3 to 5th grade. Nursery will be available as well for newborns to 3 years old. Children can be checked in to Sunday School at 9:50am. CDC and local school guidelines will be implemented. Masks are required for ages 2 and up.

If you are currently suffering from cough, sneezes, fever, chills, sore throat, headache, etc., please do not enter the building.
